ADVERSE WEATHER PHENOMENON

PRE-ALERT STATUS STATEMENT

The Directorate-General for Emergencies, based on the prediction of AEMET or other available sources, and in application of the Canary Islands Specific Emergency Plan for Risks of Adverse Meteorological Phenomena PEFMA (Decree 18/2014, of 20 March), **DECLARES the situation of PRE-ALERT.**

STORMS

Territorial scope: Autonomous Community of the Canary Islands.

Comments: Likely strong storms in the surroundings of the larger islands, without discarding them on the easternmost islands.

In weather forecasts and warnings, strong storm involves large electrical apparatus accompanied by locally strong rainfall or very strong maximum wind gusts or hail greater than 1 cm in diameter. In addition, there is a possibility that storms of higher intensity may occur on a punctual basis.
